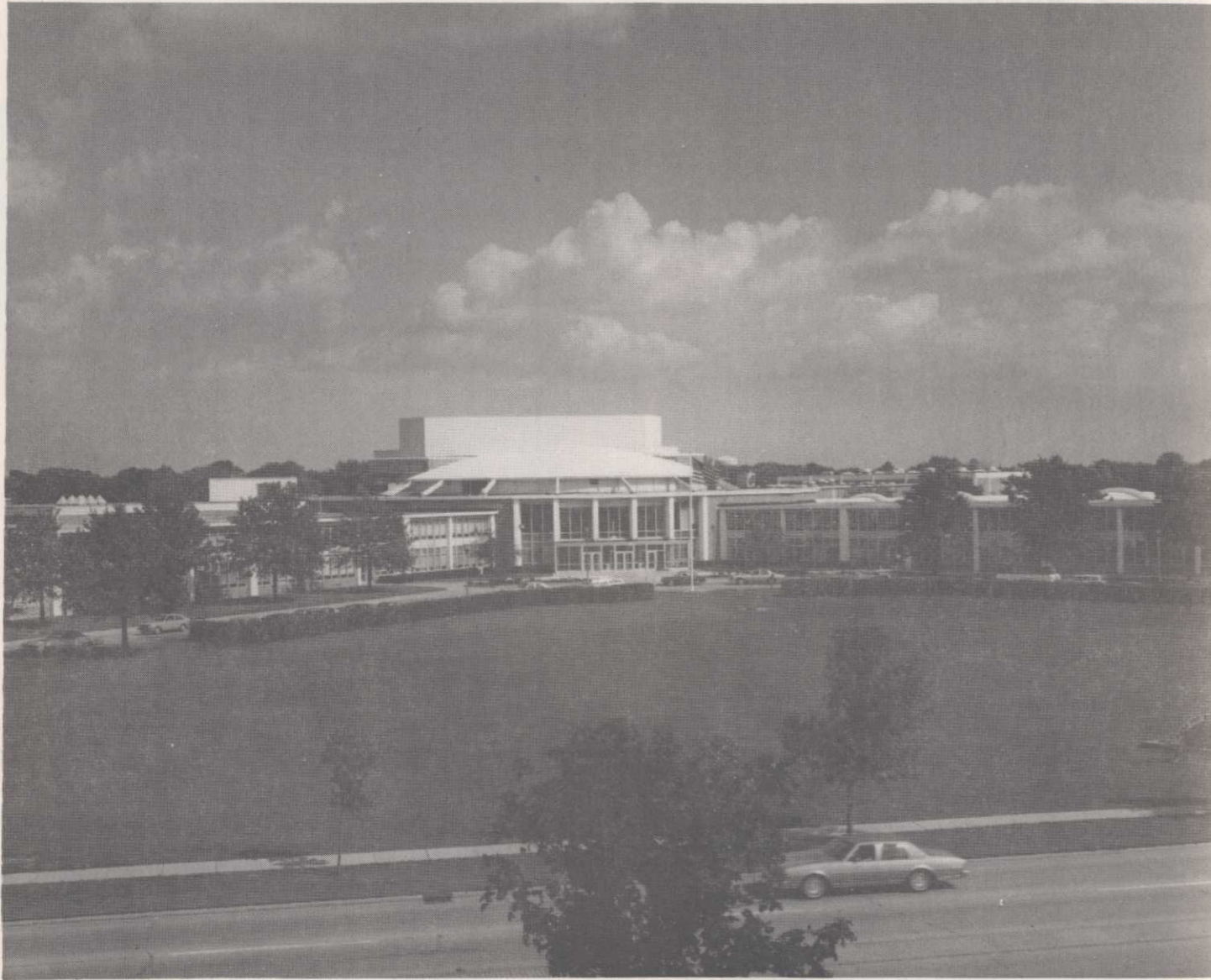




Congratulations on both your interest in your hometown of Des Plaines and your initiative in entering the Miss Des Plaines pageant.



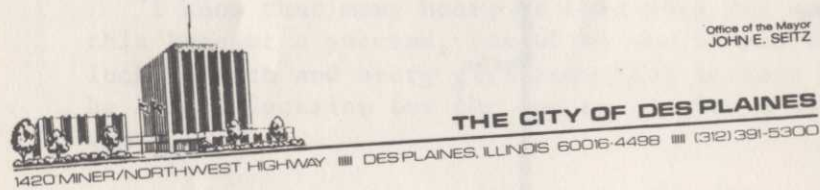


As Mayor of the City of Des Plaines and as a fellow resident, it is my pleasure to welcome you as a participant in the Miss Des Plaines Pageant.

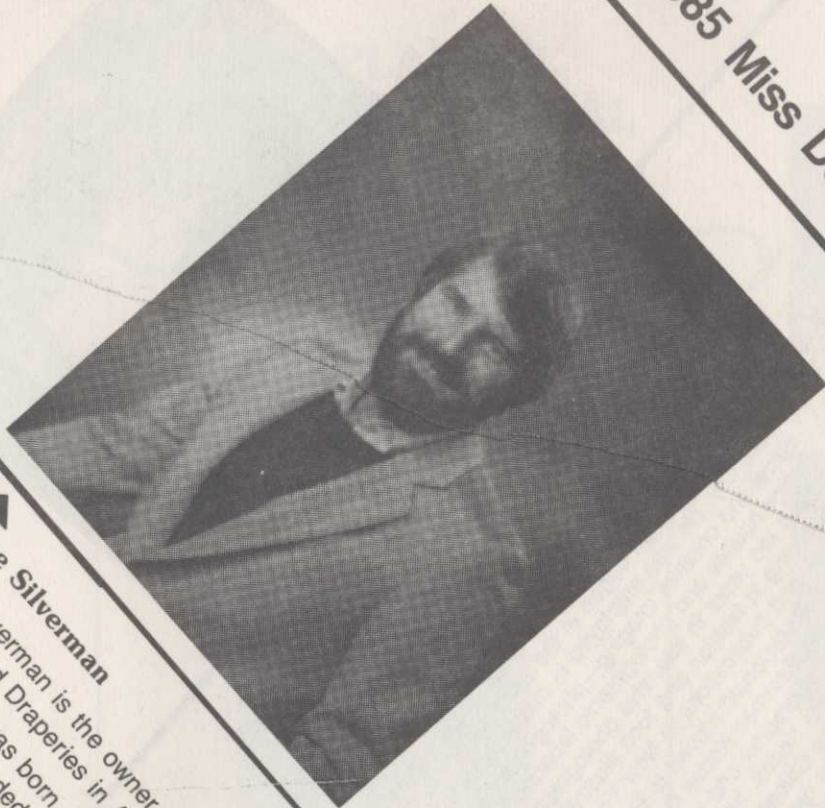

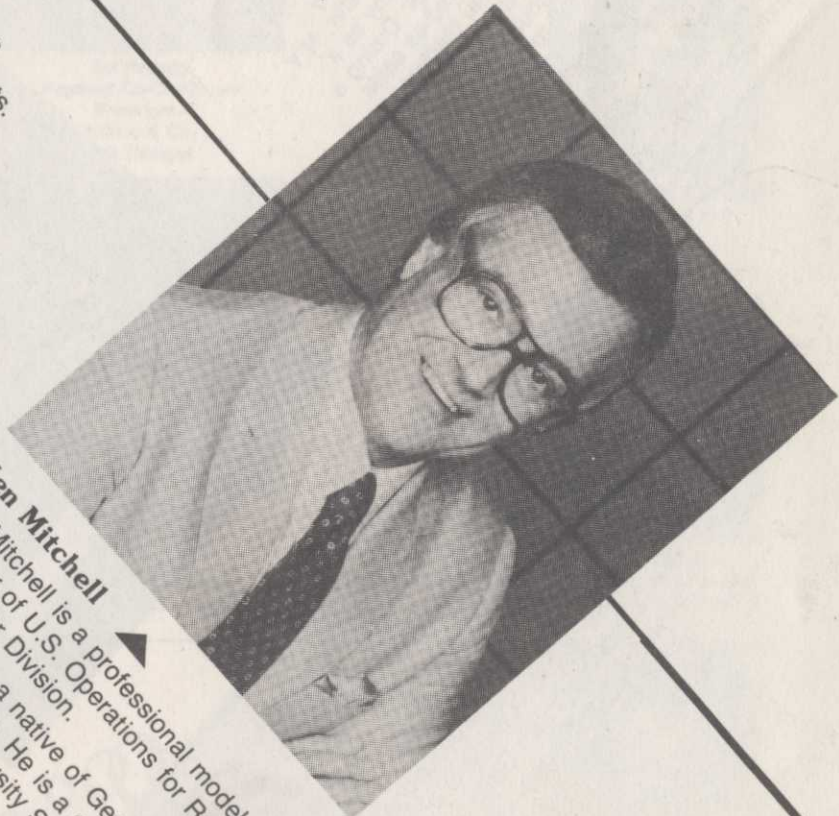

Steve Silverman

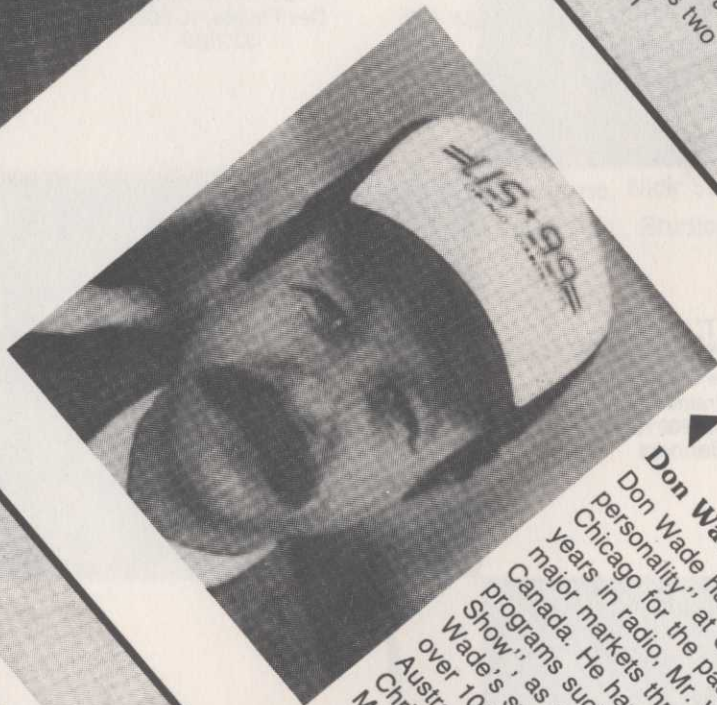
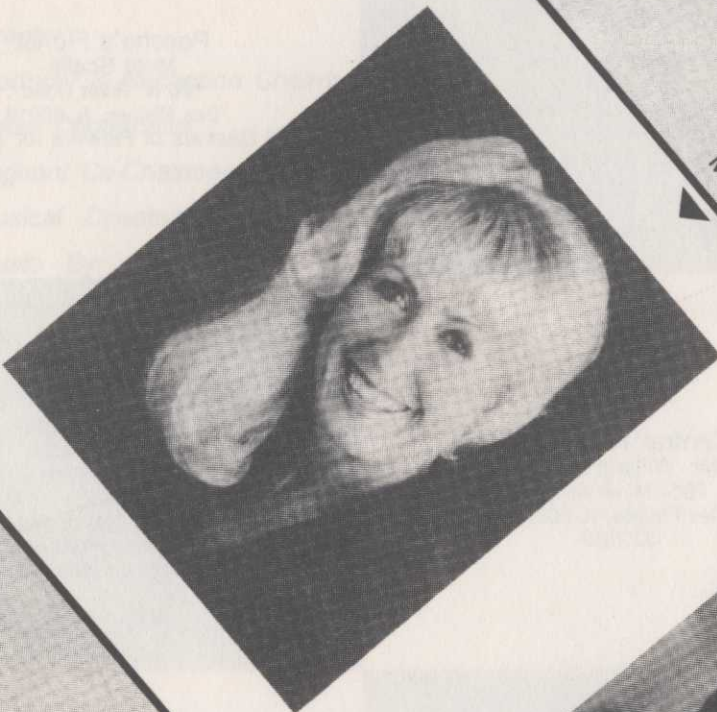

Don Wade

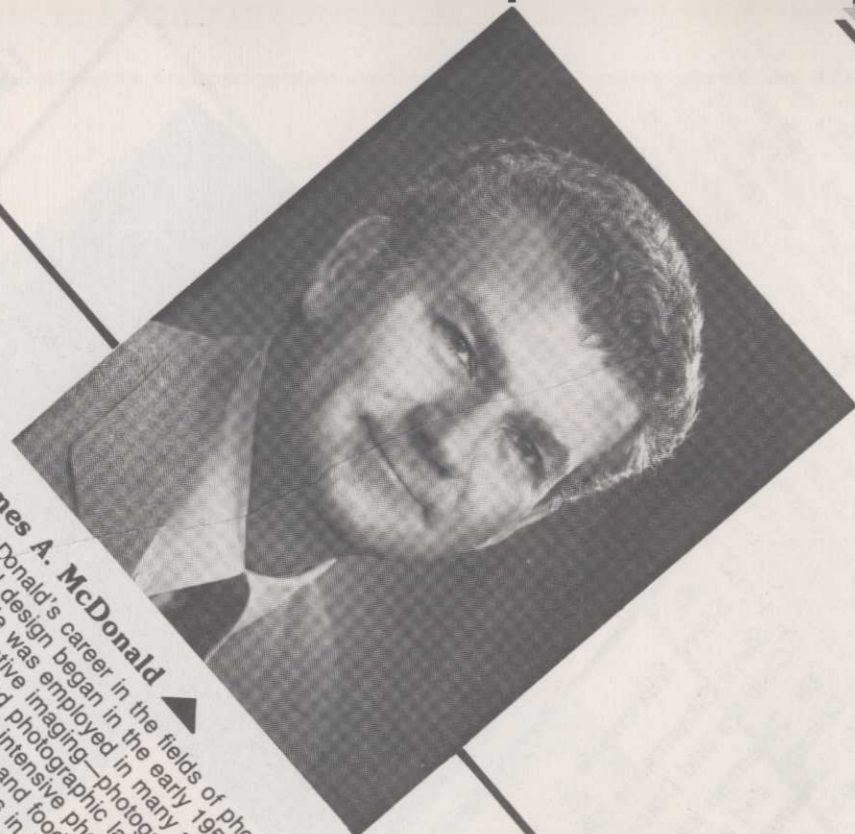

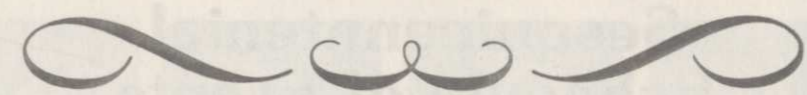
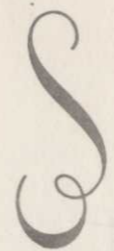


David Condit
